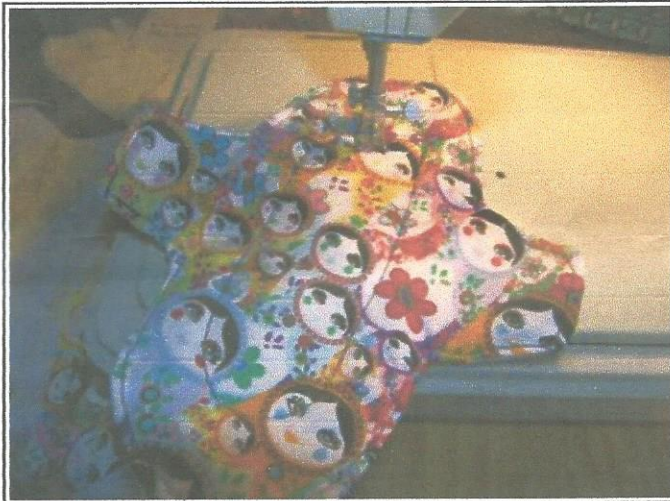


Top stitch around all pad on wrong side of pad, and close leftover opening of wing. The side with the apparent zigzag stitch is your wrong side.



The pad is nearly done now. We will just top-stitch over the center areas, both for decoration and to even out the absorbency of the pad.

8 – Top-stitch an oval shape inside the center absorbing layers.



Then top-stitch a decorative spiral inside that shape if desired (starting with center of one end of spiral, and turning pad slowly around your needle), using short stitches and going very slowly. Your first spirals might not be perfect but you'll get better with practice.

9 – Finally, fold the pad and mark the place where you want your buttonhole and button.
